


If you are travelling to the exhibition by coach, due to the one-way system, please approach the University from Holyhead Road and follow signs for the University down College Road. Staff will be on hand to direct coaches to park on College Road, opposite the Main University Building, for students to disembark.

#### PLEASE NOTE COACH PARKING IS NOT AVAILABLE.

Parking for cars and mini buses will be free of charge and staff will be on hand to direct you to the designated car park.

There is a Civil Parking Notice system in place in the University car parks. Please make sure that you display the parking permit in your vehicle, otherwise you may be fined.



# WHILST YOU'RE HERE

### WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival, please head to the main entrance located up the steps or ramp from the Main University Building car park and turn left towards Prichard Jones Hall. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the help desk in the foyer.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, the venue may be conducting random bag and wand searches. We thank you for your patience while this takes place.

### WIFI

Wi-Fi access is available at the exhibition free of charge. If you require internet access during the exhibition, please connect using The Cloud network. No password or username is required.

### ACCESSIBILITY

Prichard Jones Hall and Powis Hall are accessible. There is a ramp up to the Main University Building entrance. Accessible parking is available at the bottom of this ramp. Accessible toilets are situated on the corridor between Prichard Jones and Powis Halls. Full details on accessibility can be found on the <u>Bangor University website</u>.

### CATERING

## ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES


If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please inform event staff at the help desk.

### • WHAT INSURANCE IS IN PLACE FOR THE EVENT?
