ACCESSIBILITY

CAR PARKING

- · The University of Bedfordshire has ample parking for those wishing to travel to the exhibition by car
- Please follow directions to the University of Bedfordshire (postcode MK41 9EA)
- On campus, please follow the signs to the car parks then proceed to the exhibition registration area
- Please print out (in colour) and display the appropriate parking permit which can be found on the UCAS website
- Please be aware that those exhibitors in the Exhibition Marquee and/or Demonstration Zone will be asked to park on a field.

EVENT INFORMATION

CATERING

Please note that the exhibition will not close for lunch on either day. All catering outlets on campus will be open during the event but are expected to be busy.

Free tea/coffee will be available for teachers and exhibitors throughout the exhibition in the teachers and exhibitors lounges; located at the rear of the main marquee and next to the Sports Hall. Within the teachers and exhibitors lounges, there will also be a shop and lounge area for exhibitors to buy light refreshments and take a break.

- Campus Restaurant: Located next to the main campus theatre in D Block (10am 2.30pm)
- Gateway Café: Located in the main Gateway Building (10am 2.30pm)
- · Catering Marquee: Next to the demonstration zone, we will be setting up three temporary catering outlets serving:
- Breakfast Rolls (9.30am 10am)
- Lunch (10am 2.30pm).

ELECTRICAL SERVICES & POWER SUPPLY

- Electricity supply cannot be guaranteed but the University of Bedfordshire will try to arrange a power supply to those exhibitors who have requested it, where possible.
- Use of the venue's electrical sockets is not permitted, unless authorised, and cables must not cross gangways.
- Where power can be supplied to exhibitors' stands, it will be switched off each night, including the build-up night. Power to your stand will be switched off 30 minutes after the
 exhibition closes each day and will not be switched back on until the following morning.

EVENT INFORMATION

FIRST AID

First Aid facilities are available across the site, with a designated team of first aiders on hand throughout the exhibition. Should medical assistance be required, please request this from a member of staff or one of the student ambassadors.

INTERNET

Wi-Fi internet can be accessed on campus through Eduroam (if you work for a University that also supports this scheme). Please note that Wi-Fi access is not guaranteed.

SCANNING

To take advantage of lead scanning at this event, you need to download the Smartlead UCAS and have purchased scanning for the UCAS/Discovery events. You will need a license code per device per event which are assigned to you when you purchase the scanning. Make sure your staff at the event have been provided with the license codes.

You will find a guide to setting up your device and how to manage your data in the Exhibitor zone [link] along with a Scanning Instructions document that you can share with your staff attending the event. Hard copies are also provided on your stand.

RISK ASSESSMENTS

All exhibitors need to provide a risk assessment for your stand build and any activities that will be happening on your stand. The event organiser has completed a risk assessment for the event.

ARRIVAL

- The UCAS Exhibition is split across two venues the Sports Hall and Exhibition Marquee.
- On arrival, you are asked to register at the main entrances to the exhibition halls. You will be issued with a wristband, which will allow you access to the exhibition site.
- To gain entry to the venue, you must register details of who will be attending before the event, through your ENet account instructions on how to do this will be emailed to the lead booker.
- To access the Teacher/Exhibitor lounges, please ensure you present your Exhibitor lanyard which will be provided for you at your stand.

BUILD-UP

Build-up times are as follows:

- Sunday 16 June 2024: 14.00-18.00
- Monday 17 June 2024: 07:30-09.00
- Tuesday 18 June 2024: 07:30-09.00

Please note that from Monday 17 June 2024 (all day) to Tuesday 18 June 2024 (until 14:30), no vehicles will be allowed to directly access the exhibition halls. All unloading activities must be carried out from the main car parks (a 2-minute walk to the Exhibition venues). Exhibitors who require easy access to the exhibition halls, for example, to unload heavy items, are requested to set up on Sunday 16 June 2024, where we can park vehicles directly outside the exhibition venues.



BREAKDOWN

Breakdown time: Tuesday 18 June 2024: 14:40 - 17:30

Exhibitors must remain on their stands, and not start dismantling them until the exhibition is clear of visitors. We anticipate this to be 5 to 10 minutes after the exhibition closes, at 14:30 on 18 June 2024. To help facilitate this, and ensure health and safety is maintained, the loading doors will stay closed until the venue is clear of visitors.

If exhibitors start dismantling stands while the event is still open, there will be no alternative but to close the exhibition, irrespective of how many visitors remain in the hall. This is because stands which are broken down while visitors are still in the hall pose a health and safety risk. As stated in the exhibitors' code of conduct, all issues raised will be logged and reviewed regularly by UCAS and HELOA. The same principles apply for dismantling, as accessing.

If you think you might need extra time to build your stand (outside the build-up times stated above), please contact <u>events@ucas.ac.uk</u>. In some circumstances, early access to the venue on the build-up day may be given, but this is only with the advance permission of the organiser. If advance permission has not been granted, exhibitors will be turned away from the venue until the exhibitor build-up session starts.

ORGANISERS

The UCAS exhibition is being supported by more than 100 staff members from the University of Bedfordshire. Each exhibition area has its own designated support team led by a senior member of university staff. You can easily identify the team leaders as they will be wearing black University of Bedfordshire polo shirts. If you need to speak to your area's team leader, simply approach any member of the staff team, and they will be happy to arrange this for you.


Deliveries can be made from Monday 12 June 2023.
